



Dear JAS Assigner Applicant,

The NAWGJ JAS committee is accepting applications for three collegiate assigners. The applications are due **by July 1, 2010 (in hand, not postmarked)**. We are hoping to have the decision made by August 1, 2010. Applicants will be chosen from different areas of the USA.

The complete application is available on this NAWGJ.org website.

The position involves a major time commitment between September 15 and November 15 each season. **Ability and willingness to check email two – four times per day during the assigning period is imperative.** In addition, you must be available throughout the NCAA Women's gymnastic season to handle the last minute replacement of officials when emergencies arise (often on a Thursday or a Friday between January and March). It is a paid position based on the number of schools you are given to assign by the NAWGJ. Most assigners receive a minimum of \$1250.00. You must be flexible, open-minded, unbiased, fair and be able to work closely with other assigners and the National Assigner. This is an appointed NAWGJ position and your adherence to the principles and policies of NAWGJ, NCAA and the JAS system are imperative.
